We want to tell as many people as possible about Making Democracy Accessible.



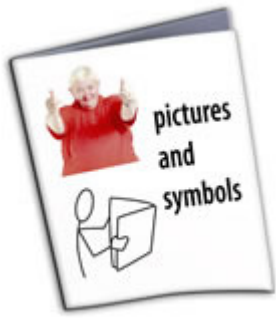
You can help us do this.

You could **ask them to make** their information easier to understand.



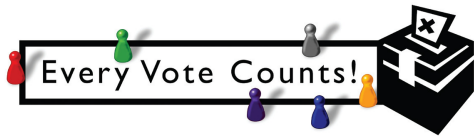
You could **write** to them.

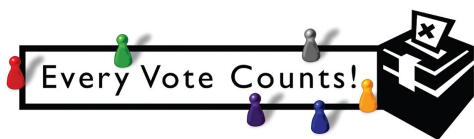

You may be a **member of a political party**.



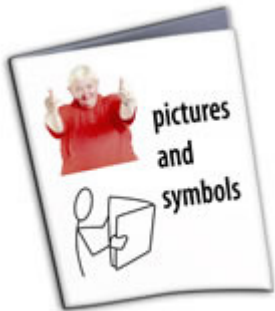
If so, **you could tell them** about Making Democracy Accessible.
